Dear Sir,

With reference to your application dated 27.3.72 on the subject cited above, I am to convey approval for adoption of Kendriya Vidyalaya syllabus in the middle classes of the above-said school for a period of one year w.e.f. 1.5.72 to 30.4.73.

This approval is, however, subject to the fulfilment of the following conditions:-

- 1) New building with labs., library, enough class rooms and craft-rooms be constructed before April, 1973.
- 2) Labs. may be equipped as per the requirement of the Board before April, 1973.
- 3) At least 2000 books from the prescribed list of library books may please be purchased for the school library, before April, 1973.
- 4) Qualified trained teachers for all the subjects including Librarian, P.T.I. and Craft teacher be appointed under intimation to the Board's office.
- 5) Reserve Fund of Rs.10,000/- be immediately created in the name of the school, the amount to be operated jointly by the Chairman of the Board and the Manager of the school.
- 6) Original B.Ed. degree of Smt. A. Satyabhama and Km. K.S. Shantha be sent to the Board's office for verification.
- 7) Km. S. Komalavalli, Km. Varalakshmi, Km. R. Shantha, Km. D. Lalitha and Smt. N. Lalitha are not qualified as they are not trained. Qualified teachers in their places may please be appointed or the teachers be asked to acquire training degree/diploma in education.
- 8) Km. T.S. Meenakshi is not qualified to teach Craft & to impart physical training instruction to Hr.Sec. classes. Qualified teacher in her place be appointed.
- 9) The question of giving permission to the school-authorities to start class IX will be considered/reviewed when the school's new building has come up.

Dear Sir,

With reference to your application dated 29.8.1972, I am to convey sanction for provisional affiliation of the Higher Secondary Department of the school under the All-India Hr. Sec. Scheme of the Board for a period of one year w.e.f. 1.5.1973 to 30.4.1974 with permission to open class IX w.e.f. 1.5.1973 for the teaching of the following subjects:-

(A) CORE SUBJECTS: English, Hindi, Tamil, Sanskrit, Social Studies & Indian Culture, General Science, Mathematics, and Electric Gadgets & their repairs.

(B) ELECTIVE SUBJECTS: Hindi, Sanskrit, Tamil, English Language Literature, Physics, Chemistry, Biology and Mathematics (Advanced).

The sanction is subject to the fulfilment of the following conditions laid down by the Inspection Committee which inspected your school on 7.6.1973:-

1) Reserve Fund of Rs.10,000/- be deposited at an early date in the joint names of the Manager/Correspondent of the school and the Chairman of the Board and a Bank Certificate alongwith the details of maturity of F.D.R. sent to this office.

2) The library should be well equipped with the books included in the list of books prescribed by the Board within a reasonable period and a list showing total number of books added on different subjects be furnished.

3) Post Graduate teachers should be appointed in the subjects which are taught as in language at higher level and electives in IX standard wherever recruitment is not already completed. Staff statement, be furnished as per proforma enclosed.

4) Pay scales and allowances and other benefits viz: Provident Fund and gratuity/allowed to the staff, should not be lower than those prescribed for the State Govt. employees for corresponding categories.

5) The laboratories and departments should be equipped as per the list of apparatus and aids prescribed by the Board and details of lab. equipment purchased alongwith the cost of equipment be intimated.

6) The school should follow the rules and regulations of the Board and abide by such instructions as may be issued by it from time to time.

The action taken/proposed to be taken by you on the abovesaid conditions may please be communicated to this office within three weeks of date of this letter.
