The School:

The School which was started in 1971 is affiliated to the Central Board of Secondary Education, New Delhi and has classes from Kindergarten to Standard XII (Co-Education).

The School imparts both academic and non-academic education to give an all-round development to the students. It affords the children excellent training in leadership through the prefectorial system and inculcates in the pupil a sense of civic, social and moral responsibility. It also gives excellent encouragement to development of skills and personality, and specialisation through suitable creative work. An ethical, spiritual and cultural attitude is developed, which is conducive for teaching and learning activities. The well-equipped laboratories, library and well-designed and furnished rooms provide congenial atmosphere.

1. New admissions are made only in Pre Kg and LKg. For other classes, admission is subject to availability of seats.
2. For admissions to Pre Kg, the child must have completed 2½ years and must be below 3 years and for LKg, the child must have completed 3 years but must be below 4 years of age as on 31st March of the year of admission.

3. As per instruction from CBSE, the academic year is from April to March.
4. The School admits boys and girls irrespective of caste / creed / religion depending on the availability of seats.
5. Application for admission should be registered by paying a Registration fee of Rs. 120/- + Rs. 30/- for prospectus.
6. All applications should be made in the prescribed form by the parent / guardian of the child with the following attachments.

Eligibility for Admission to Class XI

Candidates seeking admission to Class XI should have passed Secondary School Examination (Std. X) by CBSE. First priority will be given to students from our School. Group allotment is subject to student's ability and availability of seats.

Registration for admission does not guarantee a seat.
